(Arrive by 8:45 a.m.)

Through Tara meditation practice a person receives the blessings and protection of Tara, and all suffering and obstacles are pacified. The practice of White Tara is brief, easy to accomplish, and carries a great blessing. Participants must have received the White Tara Empowerment.

The cost is \$30 general (\$25 KDC members) and includes the practice text.
